Policies, Regulations, & FAQ's

Inclement Weather Policy:

- The Land utilizes a state-of-the-art weather monitoring system to track conditions in real-time. The system alerts us to any severe weather that could impact play.
- Weather will be continuously monitored by The Land staff and play will be suspended at the appropriate time. Once suspended, play will resume when conditions are deemed safe.
- Leagues & Local Use
 - Communication regarding play will be sent electronically if there are any impacts to the days game schedule
- Tournaments & Events
 - Inclement weather and resumption of play will be a collaborative effort between the events right's holder and The Land. Communication regarding play will be sent electronically through the tournament operators preferred method.

Concessions:

Concessions located within The Land will be open during local scheduled league games and tournaments (hours may vary based on event schedule).

Outside Food & Beverages:

Visitors are not permitted to bring outside food and beverage products into the complex with a few exceptions:

- Athletes may bring reusable sports bottles in for use at water fountains, water jugs, and hydration stations in the park.
- Coolers will be allowed but are subject to inspection. May only contain ice, team drinks, medicines, and baby food/formula.
- If you have specific dietary needs, please contact the facility.

Tents/Canopies/Heaters:

Tents and canopies are allowed in the park, as well as folding chairs. There are covered bleachers at each field. Heaters, both propane and electric, are not permitted in the park.

Parking:

Parking will be provided on-site for visitors at no charge. No parking will be allowed in clearly marked "Drop Off Areas" or access roads entering the complex. RV and oversized vehicle overnight parking is **NOT** allowed. Certain events may offer reserved parking.

Admission:

For visitors not including players and coaches, there **MAY** be an admission fee required to enter the park. Please refer to the tournament page to see if there is an admission fee for the event you are attending. Player and coach admission is traditionally included in the tournament fee.

Cleats:

Players may wear athletic shoes or molded cleats: metal cleats are **NOT** allowed on the turf fields.

Gum/Sunflower Seeds:

The Land prohibits gum and sunflower seeds from being brought onto fields. Use in the dugouts or on the fields is subject to a team fine.

Alcohol:

Outside alcohol is prohibited inside the complex. Violation of this policy may result in removal from the park.

Tobacco/Vape:

All forms of tobacco including smoking, chewing tobacco, e-cigarettes and vaping are prohibited inside the park. Players, coaches, or parents found to be in violation of this rule will be referred to the Tournament Director for discipline. A designated smoking area is available outside of the park.

Pets/Service Animals:

Pets are not permitted at The Land Sports Complex. Service animals are permitted.

Watch Out for Balls:

Games are constantly going on throughout the day, and visitors are asked to please be alert for balls that could leave the field of play.

Outside Vehicles or Carts:

Skateboards, scooters, roller skates, roller blades are prohibited.

Handicap Accessibility:

The park is ADA compliant.

Is Water Provided in the Dugouts:

Each dugout has bottle fillers for player to use.

Certified Medical Personnel/First Aid:

Certified Medical Personnel may be on-site for the duration of events.

Where can we warm up prior to the game:

There are spaces near each field for light warmups. Batting cages are available on a first come first serve basis. The Land requests each team use only one batting cage.

Recording Devices and Drones:

Camera or recording devices are not permitted to be hung on nets. Drones or any unmanned aircraft are prohibited.

Behavior/Code of Conduct:

All guests are expected to be respectful of each other, including umpires/referees and tournament officials at The Land. Unsportsmanlike and poor behavior from players, coaches, parents and/or other visitors will not be tolerated. The Land has the right to remove visitors at anytime if they are deemed to be in violation of this code. The Land | Saraland Sports and Recreation Complex fosters an environment of healthy active lifestyles and a sense of community.

The Fields (Diamond Complex)

What is the playing surface:

The playing fields are all synthetic turf maintained to an industry standard for safety. The Land fields are multi-sport and can be configured to support different sports and field layouts.

Are there Lights on the Fields:

All playing fields have state of the art LED lights.

Are there scoreboards:

The Land currently features scoreboards on key feature fields.

What are the Field Sizes:

The fields can be configured to accommodate the following fields

- Baseball: one (1) 90' Diamonds, Eight (8) 60'/70' Diamonds 350'/225'
- Softball: Eight (8)) 60'/70' Diamonds | 225'
- Soccer: Eight (8)+ Small Sided Fields
